NEW & IMPROVED! TOHR BY-LAWS GET FACELIFT

TOHR membership voted and passed the proposal to
improve the by-laws of the organization at the September
membership meeting (the meeting was delayed one week
due to recent events).

Beginning January 2002, the terms of the Board of
Directors will be two years on a rotating basis. The offices
of the President, 2nd Vice President and Treasurer will be
selected one year while the 1st Vice President and Secre-
tary will be selected the following year. The exception to
this will be this coming year when all Executive Commit-
tee positions will be elected.

Additionally, the by-law revision created the "Board
Development Committee," chaired by a board member,

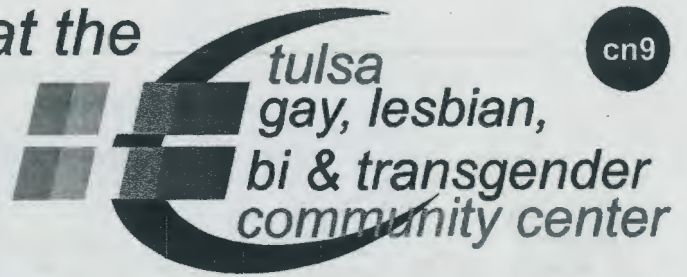

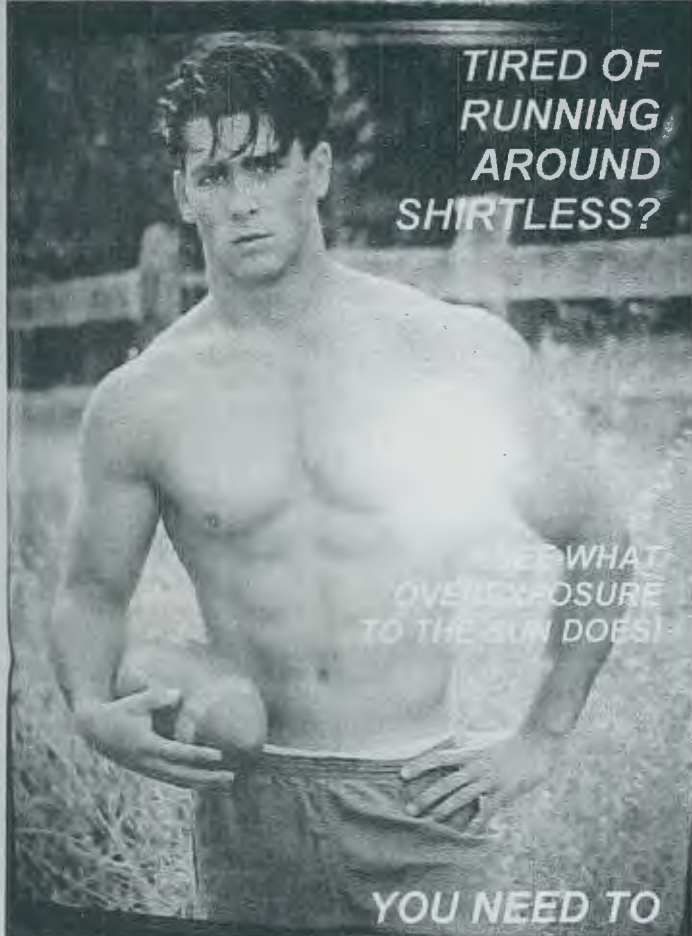

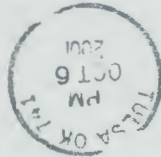
